1 plain paper copy of each page

Letters wear their special caps at special times
So run the bases in your mind.


“I” steps up to bat. He always wears his special cap.

4th activity suggestion
Fold several papers in
half and place this
cover on top with area
around the dotted line
placed against the
fold.

edges, do not cut fold
except to trim out
small indentation if
desired. Staple
Allow students to
paste capital letters
from magazines on
the page and to write
the capital letter. If
necessary use lined
paper
