Celebrate the small steps towards success.


Offer true and specific congratulations on a job well done!

Use certificates often to communicate small improvements with classroom teachers and parents

- Have students write daily success statements
- Create a celebration board
- Make special announcements
- Encourage students to praise each other
- Share the success with the principal, the janitor and anyone else willing to say "good job!"
- Make statements about how good this success must make the student feel inside to encourage intrinsic motivation, not response to rewards.

- After working so hard, it is a good feeling to know you ...






