Objective: To reinforce the use of suffixes with a variety of PBJ/L-C words and eventually with all student vocabulary.

Materials Needed: Copies of the ice cream cone answer pages for each student and one die for each student. The blank ones ice cream cones are provided for the teacher or student to create their own combinations of frostings.

Game Preparation: Write a frosting next to numbers 1-5 on master cone. 6 is wild. Place in a visible spot for all students to see.

EXAMPLE -ing could be the frosting assigned to "2". If a student rolls a "2" then they must try to use the -ing frosting on the selected word. One die for each student and answer "cone" page preprinted with frostings. These vary from each other in a "bingo" card fashion.

Game Play: Draw a word from the stack of words written on the "scoops" or write a word on the board from word list or current vocabulary list. Either way all students are attempting to use the same word. Each student playing rolls their individual die.

The number which comes up should correspond to the previously assigned numbers and the student must then see if they have a space for that frosting left on their answer key and then determine if the word showing can "wear" the frosting. If so, they write the new word, spelled correctly, on their answer "cones". If not, then the student cannot add anything to their "cone".

Remember, 6 is wild. The student who rolls a six can select any open frosting on their answer page to use with selected word.

The "winner" is the student who completes all the scoops of ice cream correctly. It is similar to Bingo in that you either have a spot available or you don't and you have to wait for the next word.

Variations: 1) Fill the blank cones with only two frostings, -ing and -ed. Then the numbers assigned would be something like rolling a 3, 5 means -ing frosting, rolling a 2, 4, 6 means -ed frosting. 2) Use the blank masters to add new combinations of frostings as they are introduced in the Blue Stevenson Language or Frosting, Doilies and More. 3) Don't use dice at all and just turn over cards and let the students add an appropriate frosting to the word and continue until someone is able to fill up their "cone". 4) Let ambitious students play several "cones" at the same time.
